# 2027 Contract – Miss Tourism Pageants

## All Miss Tourism Titleholders / Parent Agreement

Miss Tourism Pageants (hereinafter referred to as **MTP**) is honored to welcome you as a Titleholder and Delegate to Miss Tourism Pageants.

Our organization upholds a high standard of **integrity, respect, and professionalism** from all titleholders and their families (collectively referred to as the “Titleholder” throughout this contract). The following rules and expectations apply to all individuals representing Miss Tourism Pageants.

This agreement governs participation in all activities coordinated through Miss Tourism Pageants, including **local, state, regional, national, international and World** events, as well as any personal appearances or activities conducted while holding a title within the organization.

By submitting your official registration and accepting a title, the Titleholder and Parent/Guardian acknowledge and agree to all terms outlined in this contract, as well as all rules, policies, and guidelines published by Miss Tourism Pageants.

This agreement is legally binding and enforceable under applicable state and federal laws.

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### PAGEANT REQUIREMENTS

- Titleholders are **required to compete at the Next Level Miss Tourism Pageant Event** representing their assigned title.
  - Next Level Events- From State to Worlds- From International to Worlds
- Holding a title within Miss Tourism is an honor, and with that honor comes responsibility, commitment, and professionalism.
- If a Titleholder is unable to fulfill her obligation to compete at the Next Level Event for any reason, the following withdrawal policy will apply:
  - A **\$195.99 withdrawal fee** will be charged if written notice is received **more than 30 days** prior to the Miss Tourism Pageant.
  - A **\$250.00 withdrawal fee** will be charged if withdrawal occurs **within 30 days** of the Miss Tourism Pageant.
- If you won your title in a preliminary qualifying pageant state or international – Upon withdrawal, the Titleholder must:
  - **Immediately relinquish** her title to the director
  - Return the **crown, sash, and all prizes**, including any scholarship funds awarded
  - Complete all returns within **10 days** of official withdrawal

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### PAGEANT REQUIREMENTS

All withdrawal notices must be submitted in writing to:

- Titleholders are required to attend **all mandatory events** during the Competition Week. This includes remaining on-site for the duration of the event and participating in all scheduled activities, rehearsals, and appearances.
  - Titleholders may **not leave the venue** prior to the official conclusion of the pageant and must be present for:
    - All on-stage segments
    - Final crowning
    - Official post-pageant photos and media
  
- Any Titleholder who is crowned a World Miss Tourism Winner from the **required competition** agrees to:
  - Remain for the **following day after crowning**
  - Participate in the **official contract signing**
  - Attend the first **official photoshoot**
  - Complete **prize distribution and onboarding requirements**

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### NON-COMPETE & FIRST PRIORITY

- As a Miss Tourism Titleholder, your role carries responsibility, visibility, and influence. To protect the integrity and prestige of the title, Titleholders may not compete in any pageant that conflicts with their ability to fulfill obligations within Miss Tourism Pageants, up to and including competing at the Worlds Miss Tourism Live World Finals in July.
- Titleholders must receive **prior written approval** from her State or International Director or through the Miss Tourism Headquarters Office before:
  - Competing in another pageant
  - Accepting or holding any additional titles

This ensures that all commitments remain aligned and that the value and professionalism of the Miss Tourism title is upheld.

- Titleholders who earn their title through an official Miss Tourism State or International Event **must contact her director before competing in another national pageant** prior to completing their Miss Tourism World experience.
- By accepting a title, the Titleholder agrees that **Miss Tourism Pageants will remain her first priority** throughout her reign.
- This means honoring appearances, commitments, and responsibilities with professionalism and dedication.

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### DEADLINES AND FEES

- Titleholders are required to submit **all payments, forms, and required materials** by the stated deadlines. Timeliness is essential to maintaining eligibility and ensuring a smooth and successful Miss Tourism experience.
- All fees paid to Miss Tourism Pageants are **non-refundable under any circumstances, up to and including death.**
- Any items, including **crowns, sashes**, or official materials pending shipment, will **not be released** until the Titleholder's account balance is paid in full.

### SOCIAL MEDIA & APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Social media is an important part of your journey as a Miss Tourism Titleholder. It is a platform to **inspire, connect, and represent your community and the Miss Tourism mission.**
- Facebook is the preferred platform for engagement and promotion. Titleholders are welcome to utilize additional platforms as desired.
- All social media posts in crown and sash should be shared with the Official Miss Tourism Group.

- We encourage Titleholders to share their journey through their **personal social media accounts**, allowing for a more authentic and impactful connection with their audience.

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### SOCIAL MEDIA & APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Titleholders are required to follow the official Miss Tourism Pageants account on Facebook link above and Instagram [https://www.instagram.com/miss\\_tourism\\_pageants/](https://www.instagram.com/miss_tourism_pageants/) and actively engage on a consistent basis through **likes, comments, and positive interaction.**
- Titleholders are expected to post regularly on social media platforms, sharing their journey and promoting:
  - Their **local or state or international title**
  - The **Miss Tourism Pageants system**
  - The **Miss Tourism Pageant Live Event and opportunities within the organization**
- Titleholders must follow safety protocols
  - Never share where you will be prior to an event
  - Always share after the event.
  - Never post identifying information about where you live
  - Contestants may post under an alias for safety
- All posts should be shared to the official Miss Tourism Pageants Facebook account. <https://www.facebook.com/groups/officialmisstourismgroup>

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### SOCIAL MEDIA & APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Titleholders understand that their social media presence is a direct reflection of Miss Tourism Pageants. All content must remain aligned with the organization's values of confidence, leadership, integrity, and respect.
- The following are **strictly prohibited**:
  - **Provocative or inappropriate imagery**
  - **Offensive language or slang**
  - **Negative or public criticism**
  - **Content involving alcohol, tobacco, or drugs**
  - **Controversial, divisive, or harmful topics**
  - **Any behavior deemed unprofessional or not representative of the brand**

These guidelines apply to **all platforms**, including personal accounts, blogs, websites, and public appearances.

Titleholders agree to **uphold a positive and respectful public image** and may not post or share negative, disparaging, or harmful comments regarding:

- Miss Tourism Pageants
- Staff, directors, sponsors, or volunteers
- Fellow contestants or titleholders
- Any affiliated events or organizations

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### SOCIAL MEDIA & APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

Failure to comply may result in:

- **Immediate removal of title**
- A **\$250 withdrawal fee**
- Required return of **crown, sash, and all prizes**
- Potential **further action if necessary**

### APPEARANCES & COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

- Titleholders are required to complete a **minimum of two appearances per month** in crown and sash throughout their reign. Titleholders may do more, this is the minimum.
- At least **one appearance per month must be charitable or service-based**, supporting:
  - A personal platform
  - A community initiative
  - Or a cause aligned with the Miss Tourism mission of making a positive impact
- Titleholders are encouraged to attend:
  - Community events
  - Parades and festivals
  - Charity functions
  - Pageants and related events

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### **SOCIAL MEDIA & APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS**

These appearances should reflect the heart of Miss Tourism—**being visible, impactful, and inspiring within your community and each other.**

- Titleholders are responsible for:
- Booking their own appearances
- Coordinating travel and logistics
- The official crown and sash must be worn at all public appearances when representing Miss Tourism Pageants.

### **IMAGE & PRESENTATION STANDARDS**

- Titleholders are expected to present themselves in a way that reflects a polished, confident, and age-appropriate image at all times.
- Wardrobe should be:
  - Stylish and appropriate (this does not mean expensive)
  - Event-suitable (You can never go wrong with a cocktail dress)
  - Reflective of a positive and professional brand image
  - Grooming standards:
    - Hair should remain natural in color and appearance
    - Makeup and styling should enhance a clean, confident look

Additional guidelines:

- Tattoos should be covered while representing the title
- Only one earring per ear is permitted while in crown and sash
- Visible body piercings (other than earrings) are not permitted
- Public displays of affection are not appropriate while representing Miss Tourism Pageants

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## **SOCIAL MEDIA & APPEARANCE REQUIREMENTS (Princess and Preteen Divisions Only)**

- There are **no required social media obligations** for Titleholders in the Preteen or Princess, divisions.
- Within the Princess and Preteen program, social media use is **discouraged** to allow young titleholders to focus on confidence, growth, and real-life experiences.
- **However**, if a Titleholder does have social media, it may be used in a **positive and age-appropriate way** to share her journey and promote:
  - Her title
  - Miss Tourism Pageants
  - The Live Pageant Event
- Follow the same information in the social media section, for Princess and Preteen.
  - **Parents/Guardians are encouraged to monitor** all social media activities to ensure it remains safe, positive, and appropriate.

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### GROUP COMMUNICATION

**All** group chats, messages, or texts created by a Titleholder that includes two or more participants must also **include** the State Director or Delegate Coordinator.

**All Appointed Titleholders** must include a representative of the Miss Tourism Headquarters. This ensures all communication remains positive, respectful, and aligned with the standards of the Miss Tourism Pageant.

### SUPERVISION

Titleholders **under the age of 18 must be accompanied** by a parent or approved chaperone at all appearances, events, **and** while participating in the national pageant. Safety and guidance are always a **priority** within our organization.

Titleholders age **18 and older should be accompanied** by a chaperone at all appearances, events, and while participating in the national pageant. This **will ensure titleholders** are able to follow the Miss **Tourism Safety** procedures and offers much needed assistance while the titleholder is interacting with people at the event.

### BEHAVIOR

Titleholders are expected to conduct themselves with grace, respect, and integrity at all times. As representatives of the Miss Tourism Pageant, they should embody strong character both in their personal lives and in all official appearances.

Respect toward fellow contestants, directors, staff, sponsors, and the public is essential. Any form of inappropriate, disrespectful, or disruptive behavior may result in immediate withdrawal.

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### **CONT. BEHAVIOR**

**Titleholders must maintain a positive public image.** Individuals with a criminal history or involvement in inappropriate or indecent content are not eligible to represent the Miss Tourism Pageant. Any violations will result in immediate removal without the benefit of a refund.

The **use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco is strictly prohibited** while representing the organization. This includes before the event, during the event or driving away from the event. Titleholders of legal drinking age must refrain from consuming alcohol at events and should not post or share content involving alcohol while holding their title.

Titleholders are **expected to act responsibly and respectfully** at all times. Reckless behavior, misconduct, or harm toward others or property will not be tolerated.

The Miss Tourism Pageant is built on collaboration, integrity, and respect. We maintain a zero-tolerance policy for bullying, gossip, negativity, or drama. These behaviors go against the heart of our mission and will result in immediate withdrawal if verified. This includes contacting others in a bullying manner, discussing other titleholders, or spreading any type of negativity toward any person or the pageant as a whole. We will tolerate DRAMA- Do Not Contact Miss Tourism Pageants about other individuals.

### **PHOTO, VIDEO, AND AUDIO PERMISSION**

The Titleholder grants permission for photographs, videos, and audio recordings to be used by the Miss Tourism Pageant for promotional, advertising, and publicity purposes in both print and digital media. This includes, but is not limited to, social media, website content, marketing materials, and press features.

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### MISS TOURISM PAGEANTS WORLDS MISS TOURISM 2027 AGE GROUP WINNERS REQUIREMENTS

**NON-COMPETE CLAUSE** – Winners in the Worlds Miss Tourism Required Competitions, will be **required to sign a one-year contract** that **prohibits** them from **competing** in any other **“like”** pageant during the duration of their reign. If a National winner wishes to enter a school, fundraiser, or community pageant, they must receive written permission from the Pageant Headquarters Office prior to participation.

UNDER CONTRACT, WORLDS MISS TOURISM REQUIRED COMPETITION WINNERS MUST ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Must not be photographed or appear publicly in any crown, sash, or banner that was not awarded to you when you won your Worlds Miss Tourism Title.
2. Must maintain a professional reputation on all social media platforms. In keeping with the standards of Miss Tourism Pageants, parents/guardians of winners are expected to uphold the same level of professionalism.
3. If a state or regional pageant is available, must attend at least the finals of their state or regional pageant for the following season, if applicable. It is highly encouraged that winners attend as many appearances, events, and pageant activities as possible throughout their reign. The more effort invested, the more rewarding the experience will be.
4. Must maintain a polished and professional appearance at all times during official appearances. This includes appropriate hair, makeup, and attire that reflects the Miss Tourism brand.
5. Must attend the full duration of Nationals the following year in order to crown their successor. Housing, credentials, and any remaining awards or scholarships will be provided upon successful completion of the titleholder's reign.

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### LIABILITY RELEASE

The Titleholder understands and acknowledges that participation in pageant activities and events may involve certain inherent risks, including exposure to illness such as COVID-19 or other communicable conditions. The Titleholder voluntarily assumes full responsibility for their personal health and safety during participation in all Miss Tourism Pageant activities. **Titleholder is responsible for information located in this contract, on the website and in her handbook during the entire reign.**

With full knowledge and acceptance of these risks, the Titleholder agrees to release, waive, and discharge the Miss Tourism Pageant, including its officers, directors, staff, contractors, affiliates, volunteers, and representatives (collectively referred to as “the Organization”), from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, or causes of action arising out of or related to participation in any event or activity.

The Titleholder further agrees not to bring any legal action against the Organization and agrees to indemnify and hold the Organization harmless from any claims, damages, or expenses, including those related to illness, injury, or unforeseen circumstances that may occur during or as a result of participation.

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### AGREEMENT & SIGNATURE

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have read, understand, and agree to abide by all rules, requirements, and expectations set forth by the Miss Tourism Pageant.
